### **Staff Professional Development:**

At the beginning of this school year the staff had two days of professional development. This focused on the safeguarding of children, improvements to the curriculum and Growth Mindset.

### **Growth Mindset;**

A child's ability to achieve can be affected by how they see themselves as learners. As adults, we can influence this view of what a child thinks they can do.

We are encouraging all of our children to believe in their ability to achieve whatever they set their minds to. We will be using lots of encouraging language to do this. We learn from our mistakes, so mistakes are good and to be encouraged. As a parent you can help by using some of the following sentences.

### **If your child says:**

I can't do this.....Say Not yet but what do you know that will help you?  
I don't understand... Say What are you missing?  
I made a mistake Say Mistakes help us learn.

I know you put a lot of effort into your task.  
Getting better takes time and I can see you improving.
