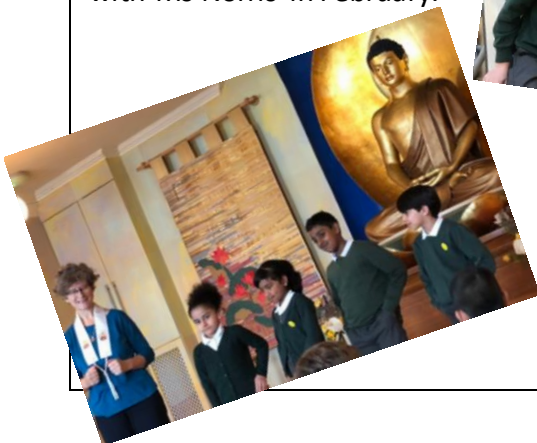
Future Leaders
