



## WDPS Catch Up Premium Proposal 2020/21

Within this financial year (Sept 20 - March 21), we are expecting to receive £9,000 from the government to support children's catch up - this constitutes 7/12 of the total offer. We will undertake an impact evaluation at the end of each term to assess the extent to which we are achieving value for money and impacting the attainment of the children.

Amount	Purpose	Proposed Impact
£9,000 = 45 days  (90 half day sessions)	To pay teachers to deliver half day sessions during the school holidays to groups of no more than 4. We are using school staff so that relationships underpin the tuition and the children are more likely to feel comfortable and ready to learn. The tuition will take place on the school site on Monday 26th and Tuesday 27th October; Monday 21st and Tuesday 22nd December; Monday 15th and Tuesday 16th February.	Children have the opportunity to catch up and thereafter keep up by virtue of excellent, relationship-rich, targeted intervention.

### WDPS' Catch up offer

- Through formative and summative assessment, teachers will identify children who require additional support to address the gaps in their learning.
- Children who have had a period of absence due to self isolation may be identified as needing catch up intervention.
- Children with similar intervention needs will then be grouped.
- We will then decide on who is best suited to run the intervention.
- They will then plan for and teach the gaps alongside the current year's curriculum to ensure that learning is systematic and in context.
- The targeted children will attend school for 2 half days for personalised tuition in the October half term, the Christmas break and the February half term.
- We will review the impact and set a further plan from April, when we receive the next funding stream.
