

<p>Listen to Ms Islam read a story called Zak and Zee. Before you start watching the video, what do you think it will be about?</p> <p>Phonics sounds teaching will commence from Wednesday 6th January 2021.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Count to 20 and workout! Look at the counters on the tens frames. How many are there altogether? Use the add/plus sign to create number sentences for each question. <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 10px;"> <p>Example: These tens frame show me that 10 + 1 = 11</p> </div> </div>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Draw a picture of something you did during the winter holidays. Write about what you've drawn. <p>Example:</p>  <p>During the holiday my brother did fireworks in the garden. I loved looking at the different colours lighting up the sky!</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Watch the time-lapse video of a growing seed. What changes do you notice happening to the seed? <p>Question - What do you think a plant needs to grow and survive? How could we find out?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> This story will help us learn about how seeds grow. Watch & listen carefully to the story. First draw a picture of a seed - now try to remember the different things that the seed will need to grow and write them down or draw them.

Help your child access the video.	Draw the tens frame and use concrete objects to replicate the pictorial ones on the worksheet.	Encourage your child to say the sentence out loud first, before writing it.	Time-lapse video - frequently pause the video to allow your child to comment on the changes they see. Does your child have any experience of planting seeds?

In addition to the above activities, exercise is very important for your child's health and wellbeing.

Limit the time your child spends on electronic devices and always monitor what your child is accessing online.
