



Please use only a few words, e.g. Count to 20.</b></p>	<p>Ask your child if they remember the features of a diary entry - they can point it out in the example above.</p> <p>When your child signs off their diary entry, remind them to write Zoo and not their own name as they are writing the diary entry as the character of Zoo.</p> <p>Link to the <a href="#">story</a>.</p>	<p>At WDPS we think that Music is an important part of your child's learning.
