If you do make it, please don't forget to send in pictures and tell us how it went!</p>	<p>If you do not have all the ingredients required for this activity, do not worry, the steps might not all happen on the same day. Tell your child that they are still on Step 1 and can move to Step 2 when the ingredients are sourced. Encourage your child to problem solve - What could we do if it looks too wet or too dry?</p>
