Mrs Salim's groups the **'Parrots and the Robins'** please watch this [video](#). You will be learning pre-ditties.



What are your favourite parts of the story?


Who are your favorite characters? Why do you like them?






5. Get comfortable in your Pajamas and choose a few stories to listen to. Do you recognise any of the teachers?


