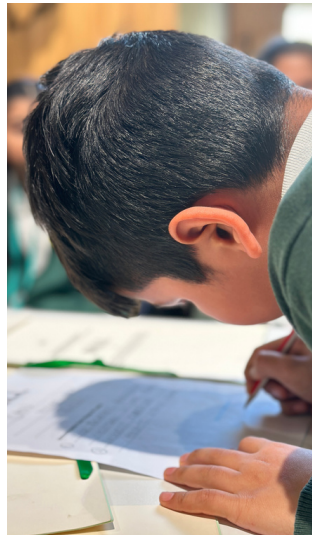

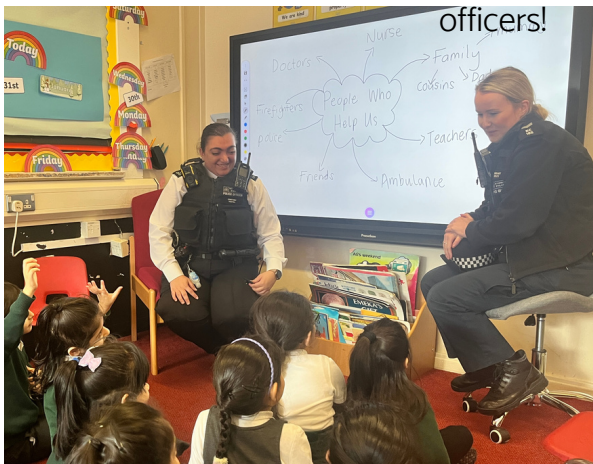
WDPS Ambassadors Make their Voices Heard!
